2007 College Scholarships Available

The focus of the American Indian Education Center (AIEC) Scholarship is to help Ohio Native Americans to further their education by providing financial assistance. Every year AIEC presents a scholarship to a deserving Native American. One \$1000 scholarship will be awarded for the academic year of 2007-2008. The scholarship will be given in two installments—the second installment of \$500 is contingent upon the recipient maintaining at least a 2.5 GPA during their first semester. Transcripts or a grade report will be required as proof of the attainment of a 2.5 GPA.

The scholarship recipient will be required to attend the 2007 Competition Powwow and Festival which will be held from June 15 through the 17, 2007 at Edgewater Park in Cleveland, Ohio. A formal presentation of the scholarship will occur at the Powwow.

Eligibility qualifications for the scholarship are as follows:

- 1.) Native women or men
- 2.) Tribally enrolled or tribal reference(see page 4 of the application)
- 3.) Cumulative semester GPA requirement of 2.5
- 4.) Resident of Ohio or currently attending an Ohio college
- 5.) Recommendation letter from a non-relative
- 6.) School transcript (unofficial copy is fine)
- 7.) Completed scholarship application received by May 18, 2007

The Scholarship Committee will review all applications. Applicants may be required to participate in an interview with the Committee. The recipient of the scholarship will be notified by June 1, 2007 and will be required to attend the June 2007 Powwow for the scholarship presentation. The scholarship dollars will be sent directly to your college/university or trade school for tuition, books, or dormitory charges.

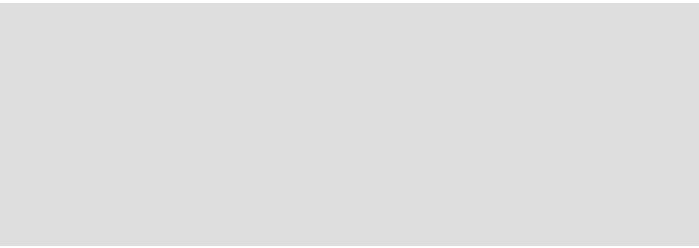
